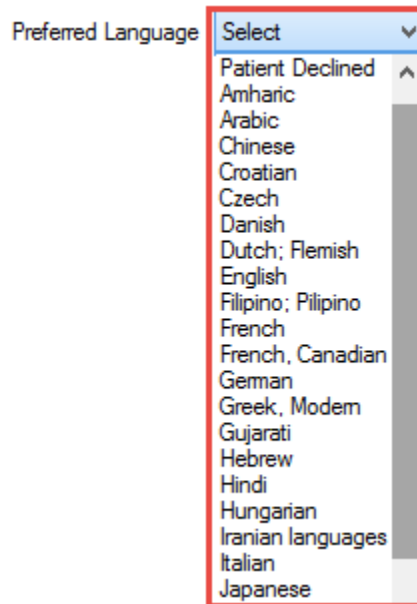

Functional Enhancement Details

Patient Demographics: Language, Race, Smoking Status, Secure Email

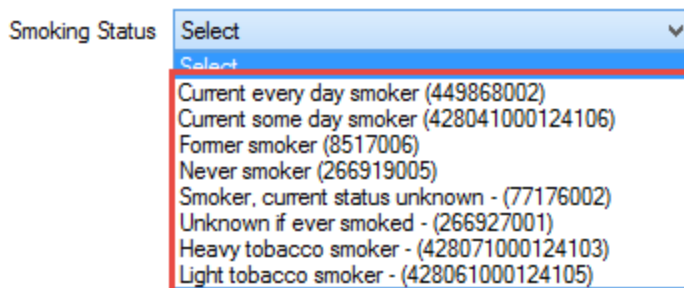
As part of PayDC's certification for Meaningful Use Stage 2, the following enhancements to the Patient Language, Race and Smoking Status are now available to all users.

Additional languages are available for selection under **Preferred Language**:



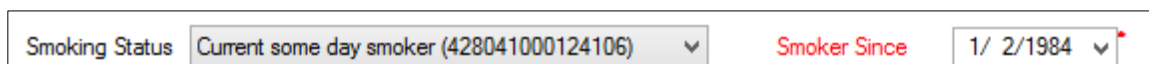

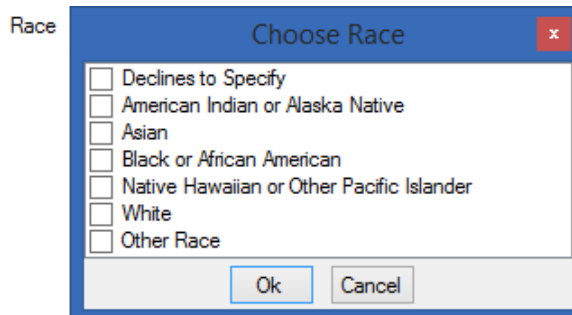

Disregard the SNOMED code numbers displayed in parentheses after each status – these are required for Meaningful Use Stage 2 but will not affect the way the status is selected or used. Note that if you select a smoking status other than “Never Smoker” or “Unknown”, then a **Smoker Since** field is displayed to enter the approximate date when patient began smoking. This is also a requirement for Meaningful Use Stage 2.

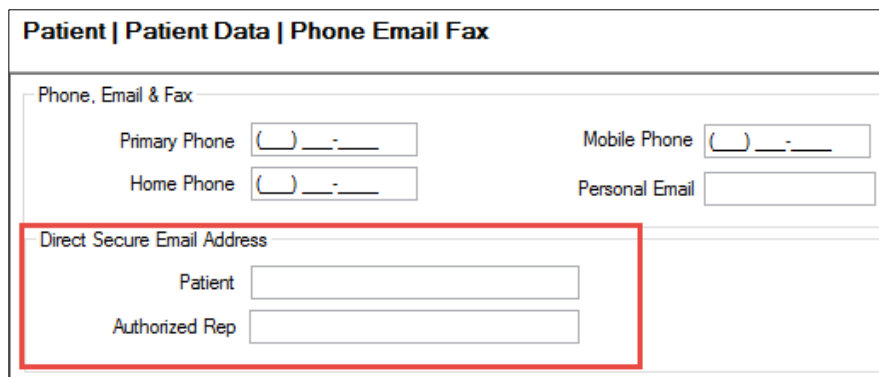

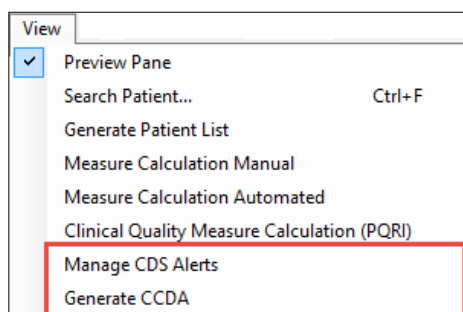

View Menu: New Menu Options for Meaningful Use

Two new menu options have been added to the View menu: “Manage CDS Alerts” and “Generate CCDA”. This functionality is only needed for Meaningful Use Stage 2, and providers eligible for that will receive separate, detailed documentation and training for these new features.

SOAP Notes: Vitals, X-Ray Images/Reports link & Clinical Document Details

As part of PayDC's certification for Meaningful Use Stage 2, the following minor changes to SOAP Note features will be available to all users.

Under **Vitals** (Objective > Exam Findings > Vitals), several fields allow only numeric values, including height, weight, temperature and blood pressure. If any of these fields contain an invalid character, it will be outlined in red and an explanatory message will be displayed. The "OK" button will be disabled until corrected.

If a patient has anything in the File Cabinet under the category "X-Ray Images" or "Imaging Reports", then a link will appear in the Patient section of the SOAP note with the date of that document. Clicking on the link will open the most recent document from either category. Use File Cabinet to view other documents that may be older than the most recent. If there is no link, then the patient has no documents in the File Cabinet under those categories.

This section is visible to everyone, but is not needed except when exchanging CCDA documents for Meaningful Use Stage 2. Stage 2 Providers will receive separate, detailed documentation and training for this and other Stage 2 features.
