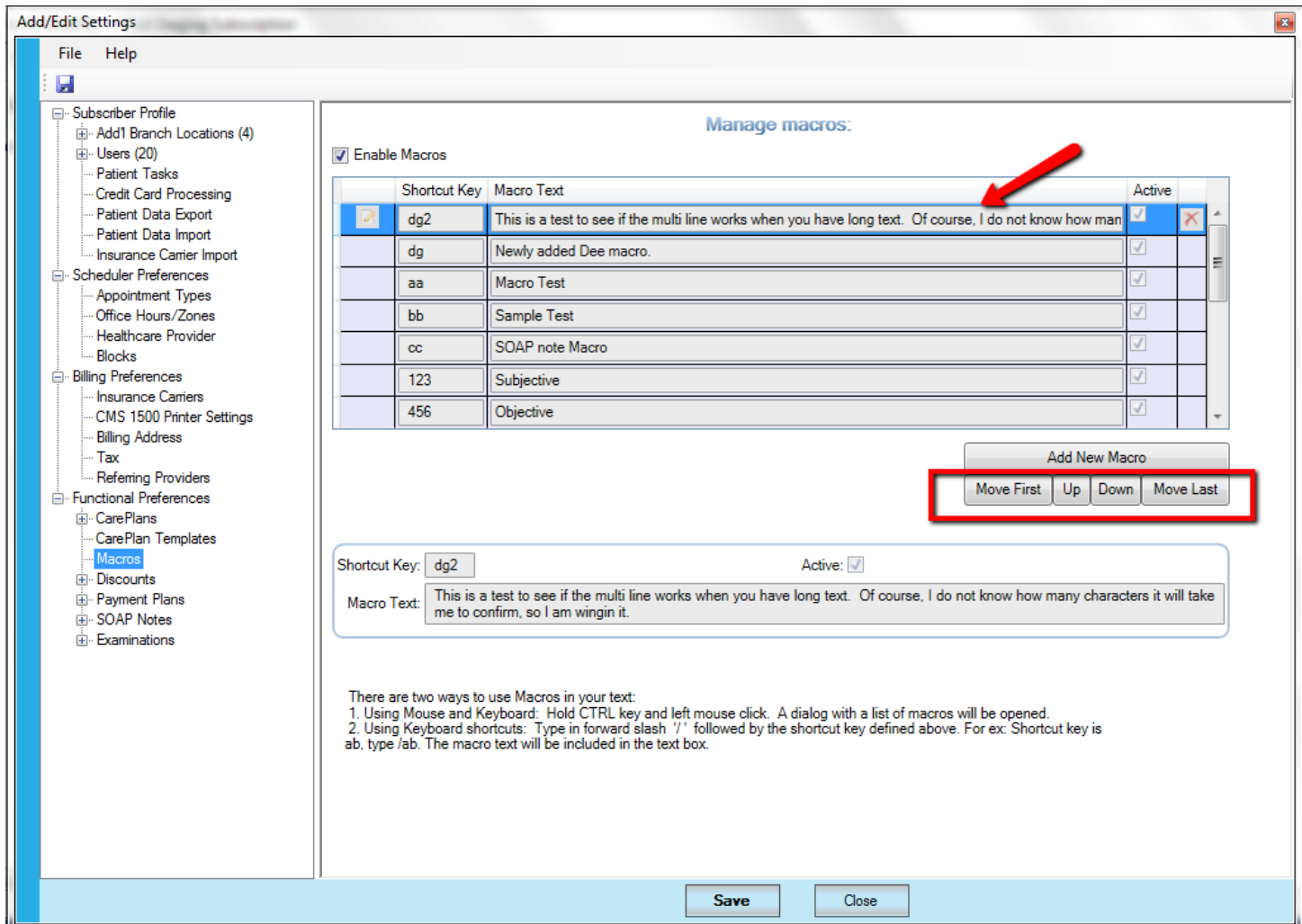
Functional Enhancements

- ✓ Care plan: When printing a care plan that is more than one page, have a footer at the bottom of the subsequent page(s) to identify the patient.
