Functional Enhancement Detail.

On the Notes screen, all “Additional Notes” and “Addendum” fields now have a new ellipse button to allow selection of text when using macros function on a tablet. Now you can get to macros by doing control-click or by clicking the New button (on a desktop or laptop machine) or use the new ellipse button (on a desktop, laptop or tablet).

This feature is also available on Sticky Notes.

This is a further enhancement of the Macros feature released on February 20, 2015.
