Latest Features and Update (October 14, 2015)

Enhancements and support

Here's what's in this release (October 14, 2015)

Enhancements

- We have added a validation to ensure users do not add duplicate ICD-9 codes with the same "title," as this causes issues during searching.
- Users can now search for ICD-10 codes by description field as well as code on the SOAP notes screen (consistent with elsewhere in the application).
- We have added availability of the Q6 modifier (services rendered by a locum tenens physician) for procedure codes.
- Several performance enhancements.

Support:

- We continue to address issues with diagnosis code order, and this release contains fixes for several additional areas where code order issues were still occurring.
- We have addressed an issue where users could not create a new ICD-9 care plan.
- We addressed an issue where the PayDC system was crashing completely after a user completed and saved a wellness care plan.
- We fixed a problem where templates converted from ICD-9 to ICD-10 were missing some custom equivalencies until application restart.
- We also fixed an issue that was causing blank equivalents to show up in the crosswalk.
- Other minor bug fixes.
