Enhancements and support

Here's what's in this release (January 21, 2016)

Enhancements

- We continue to make changes to support our new D2P billing platform.
- We continue to smooth and improve filing of claims through our new clearinghouse partner.
- We have added Cortical Integrative Therapy Taxonomy code 111NX0100X.
- We've added a checkbox in Carrier Profile to allow users to easily set "use qualifier 431 as default for box 14".
- We've added several field-level validations to prevent issues caused by invalid or incorrectly edited data.
 - Once a ROM type is used in a SOAP note it can no longer be changed.
 - Validation on date field on Demographics/Eligibility Info.
 - In Patient Profile, if Self Pay is not checked, at least one carrier must be specified.
 - Validation on Demographics/Date of Birth field to check for reasonable dates.

Support:

- We've fixed an issue where if a new patient was created from the Add Appointment screen, that patient was not immediately available for selection from the drop-down.
- We fixed an issue where, for APS customers, printing the MU dashboard caused an exception (due to a missing logo).
- We fixed a data issue (duplicate records) that was causing the ICD-10 Settings screen to not provide a full list of codes to set as equivalents.
- We've corrected the system so that if an X code is chosen in SOAP notes, the 59 modifier is not required.
- We fixed an issue in reporting CPOE radiology results for our Meaningful Use clients.
- Other minor bug fixes.
