Functional Enhancement Details

SOAP Notes: Add New Procedures to Plan without Specifying Body Area

When adding a new procedure from the Plan section of SOAP Notes, the “Add new procedure” popup now allows you to indicate that a body site does not apply to the procedure. If you check the “Body areas/sites not applicable” box below the body image, you will be able to save the procedure without specifying a body area or site.

If the box is not checked (the default), then you will still need to specify one or more body areas or sites in order to save the procedure to the Plan.

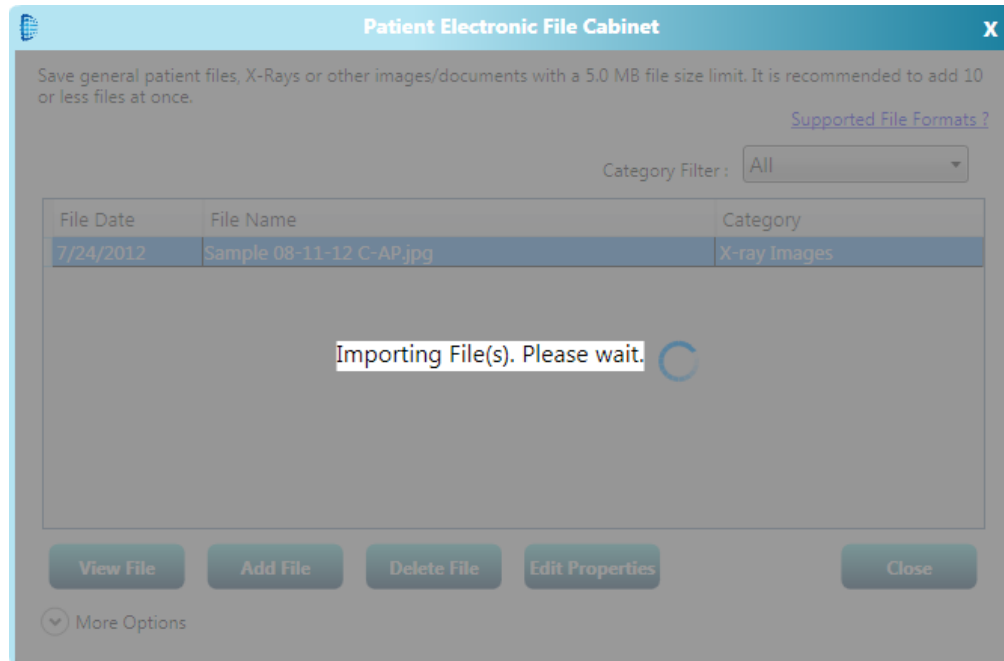

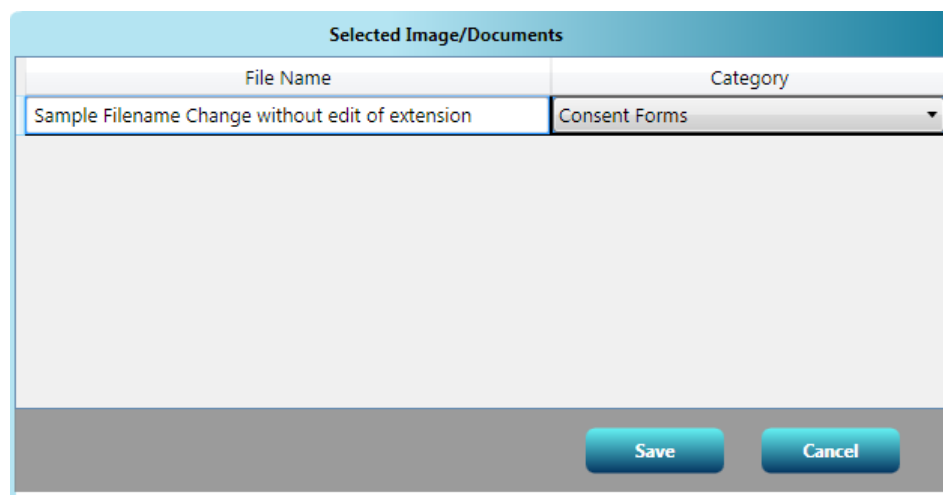
File Cabinet: Show Indication of Upload in Progress

Since the File Cabinet now supports the import of multiple files at once, it can take some time for all files to be fully uploaded. While the import is in progress, you will now see a message and a blue circular progress indicator. Once all files have been imported, the message and indicator will disappear and the imported files will be listed in the File Cabinet.



File Cabinet: Allow File Name Changes without Affecting File Extension

When you import a new file, or Edit Properties of an existing file in the File Cabinet, the file extension (.pdf, .doc, etc.) is hidden. This allows you to change the file name without accidentally changing the extension. Once the file name change is saved, the full name with extension is displayed in the File Cabinet list.



Resolved Issue Details

SOAP Notes: Save Workflow with Note to Prevent Out of Synch Condition

In rare instances during periods of peak system usage, the link between the Workflow and the SOAP Note could become out of synch. No data was ever lost, but without the link, the Note would seem to “disappear” from the list until Support was able to correct it. Changes have been made to ensure that this condition will no longer occur because the Workflow link is now saved as part of the same transaction as the SOAP Note.
