Here's what's in this Release (October 3rd, 2023)

This is the first of two enhancement releases to improve the software with regards to body areas/sites to provide better specificity, clarity and continuity.

In the Subjective Section of the SOAP Notes Screen: We've made several changes to the body model in this section to replace vague terms of body sites with more descriptive ones and to also use layman's terms that would be easily understood by patients.

Terminology Update:

1. Renamed "Thigh" (on Anterior and Posterior) to L and R "Upper Leg" (on Anterior and Posterior).
2. Renamed "Leg" (on Anterior and Posterior) to L and R "Lower Leg" (on Anterior and Posterior).

Complaint Block Display:

When selecting the leg area for display, you will now see "L-Upper Leg" for the left upper leg and "R-Lower Leg" for the right lower leg, reflecting the updated terminology.

Renaming of Muscle Group:

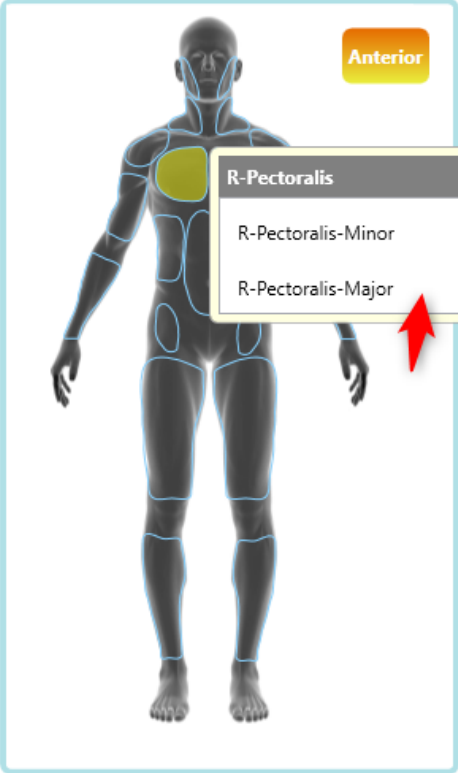
The muscle group "L and R Pectorals Major" has been renamed to "L and R Pectorals" to streamline nomenclature and improve user understanding.

"L and R Pectoralis Minor" has been added to distinguish the minor pectoral muscles.
